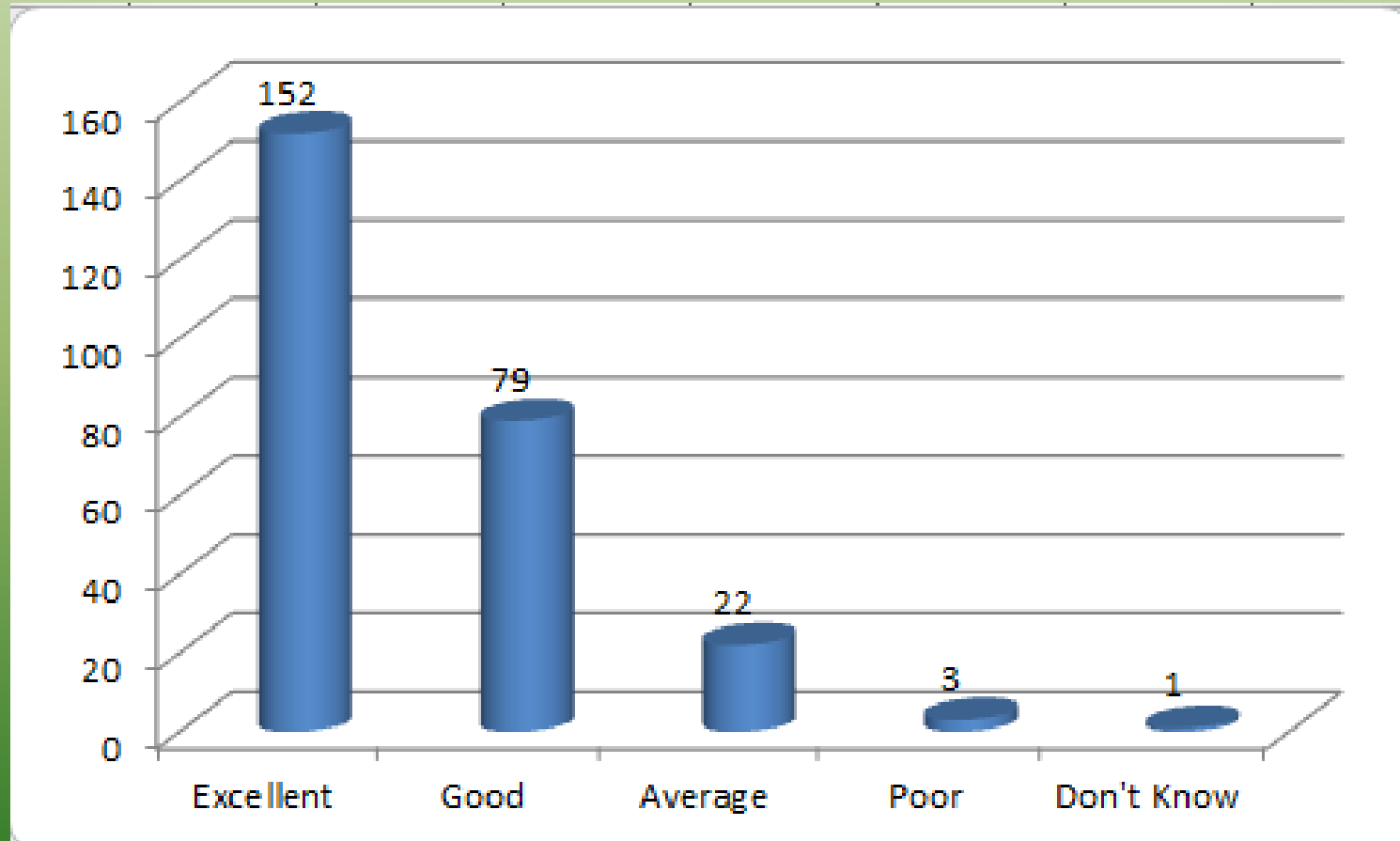

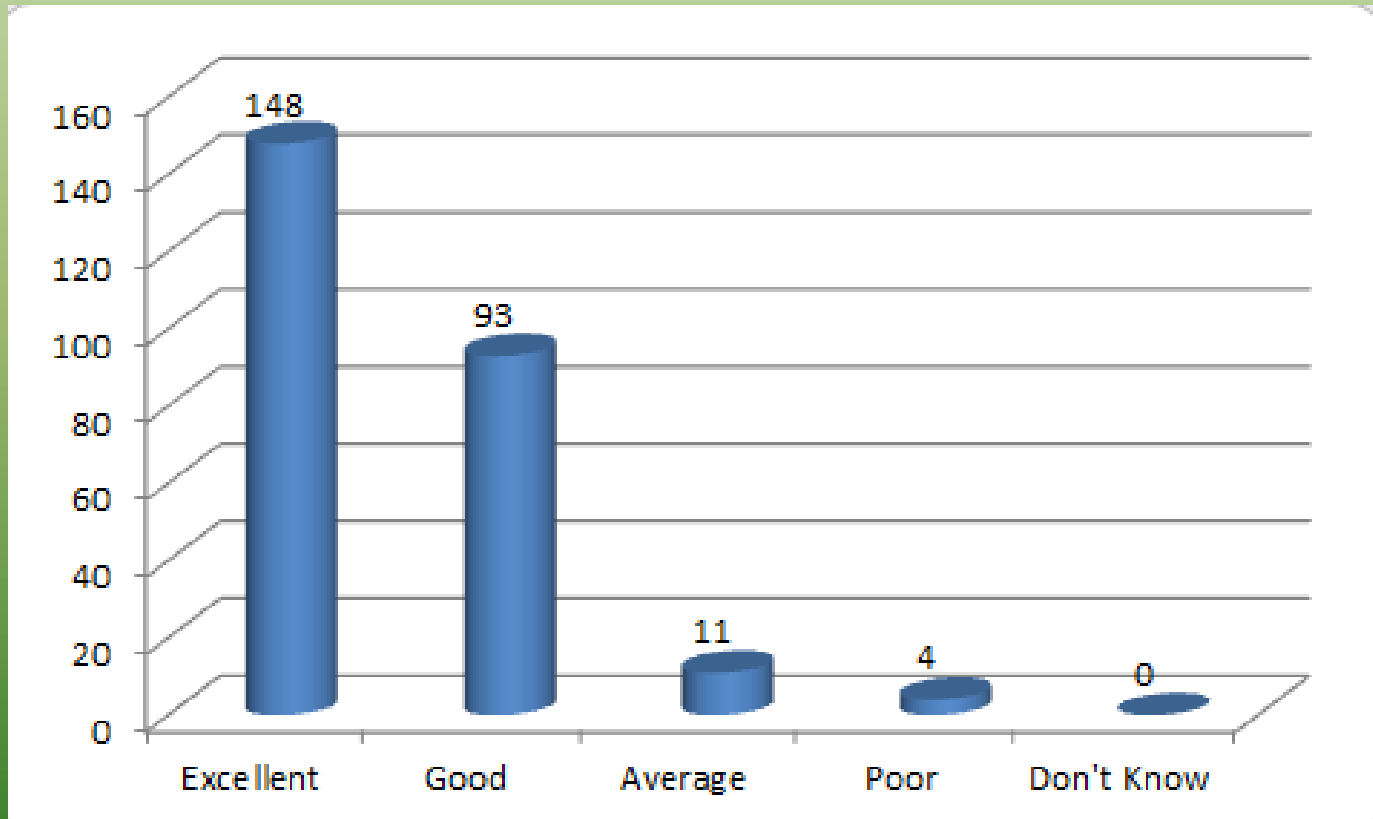

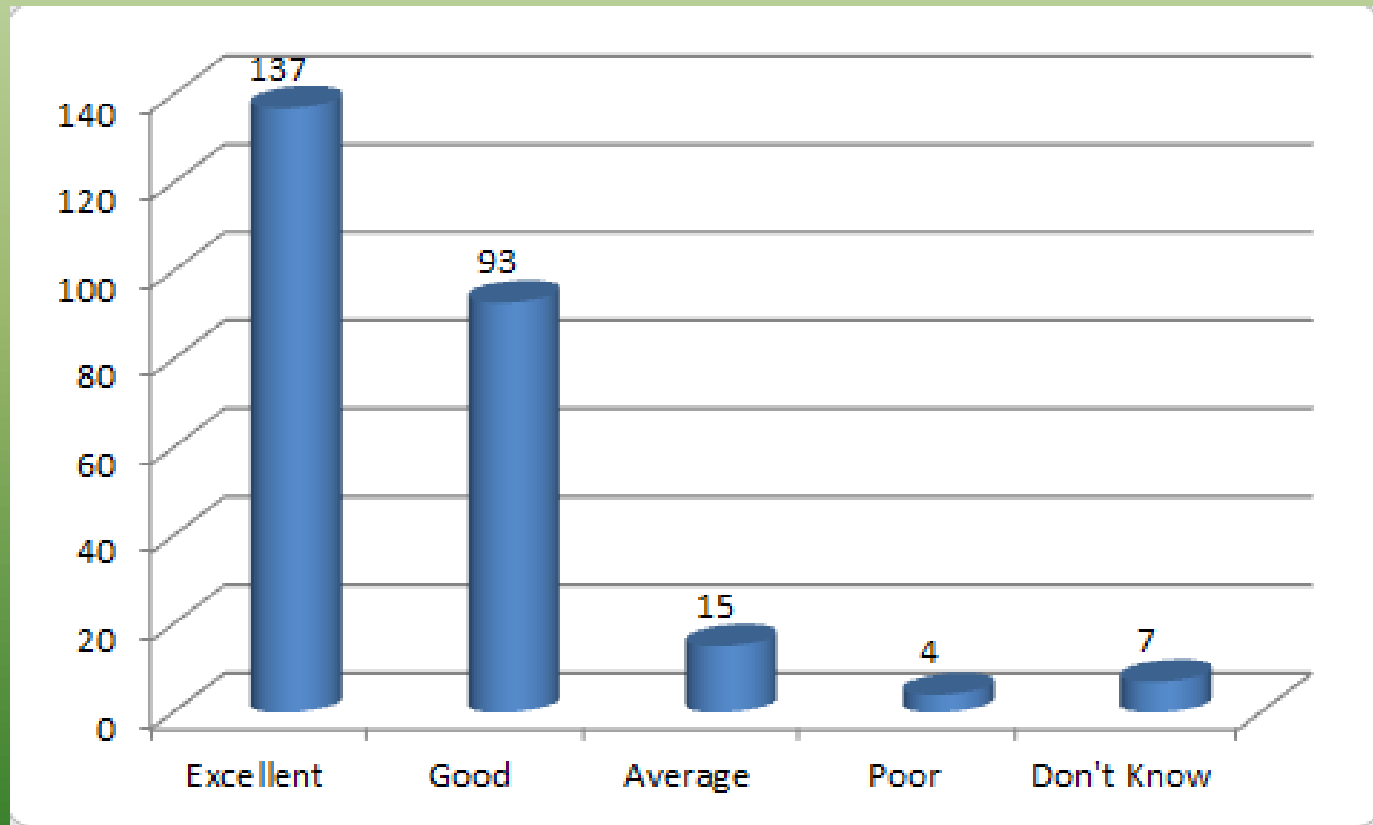
School personnel make you feel welcome when you come to school.



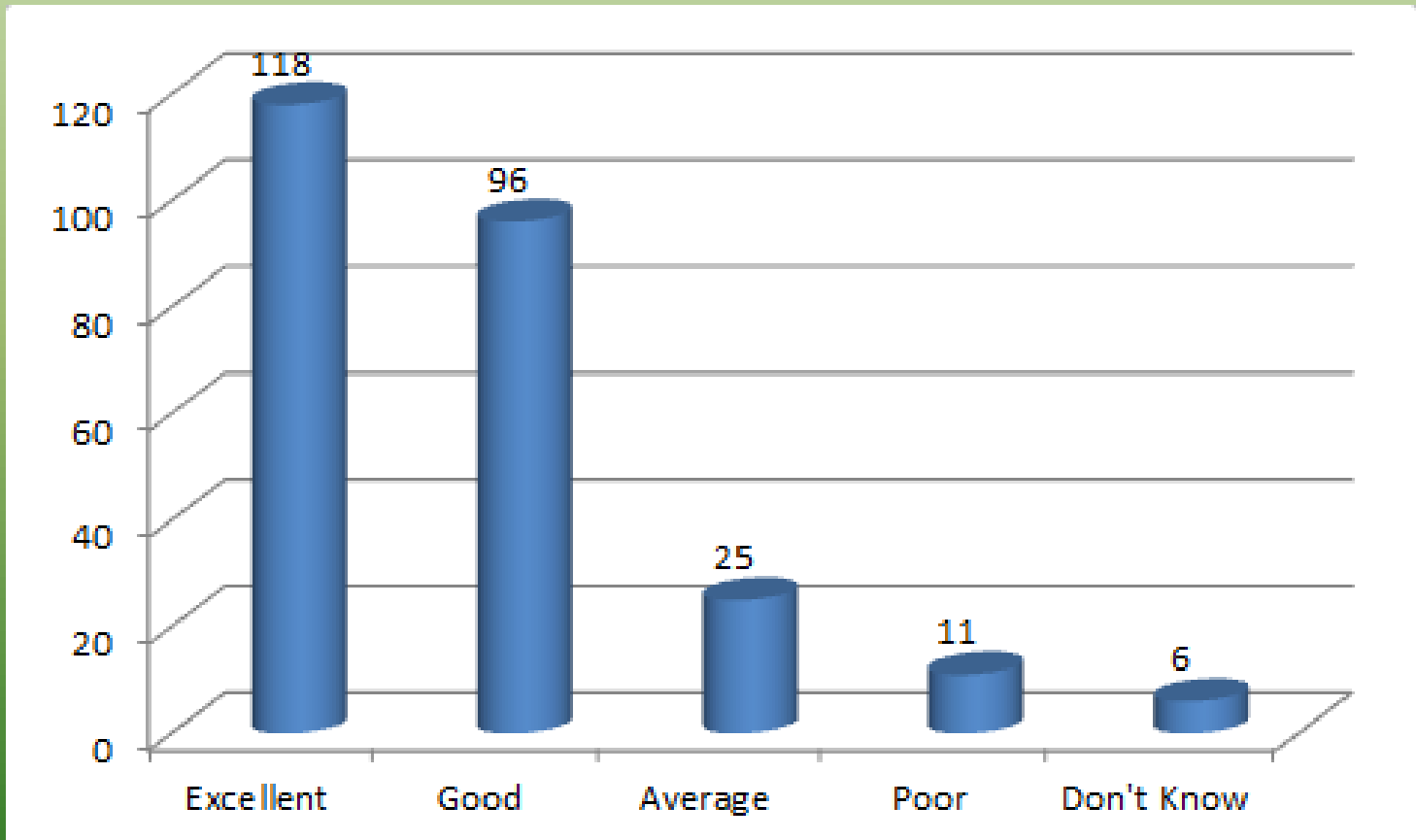
School personnel treat you with respect.

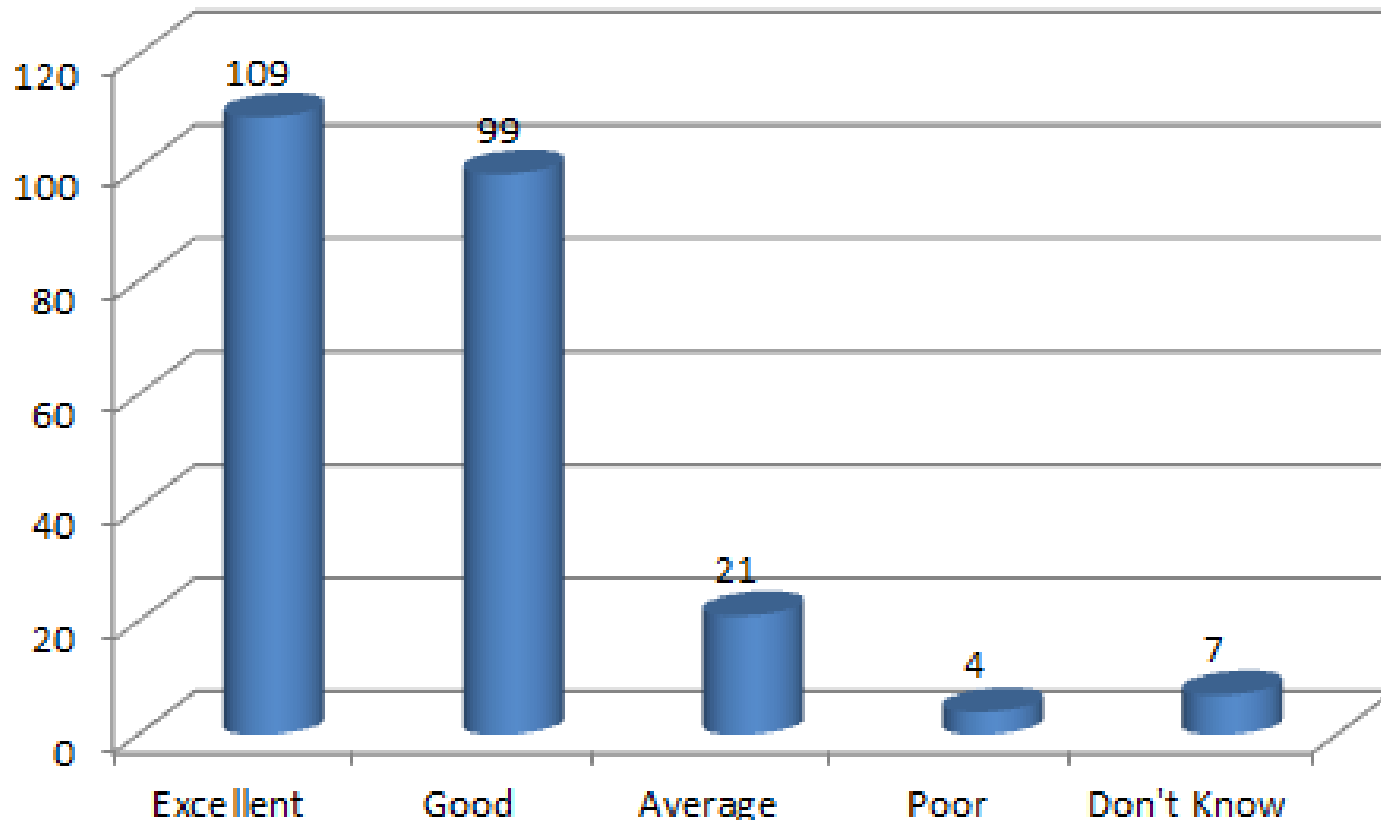
The school emphasizes academic learning.



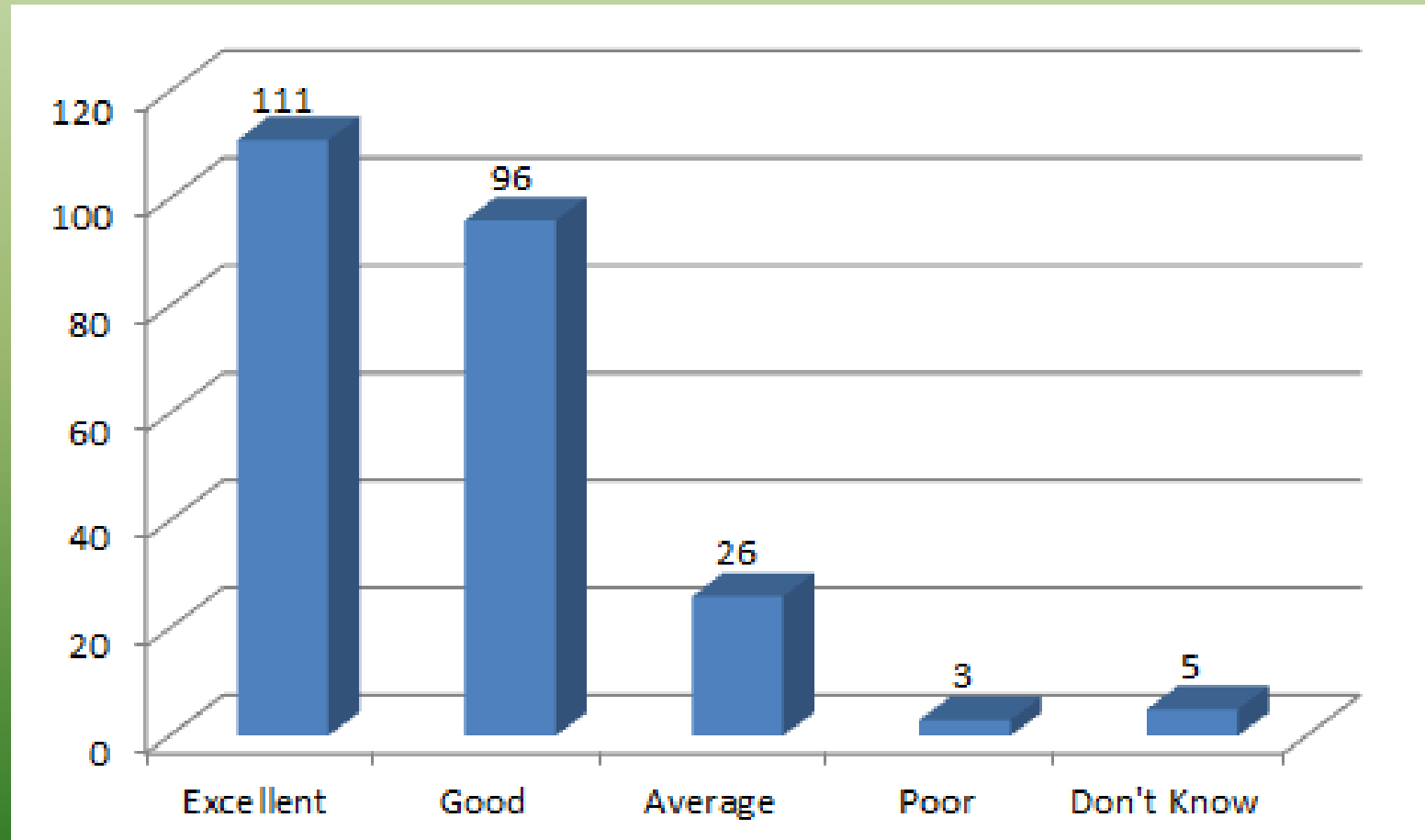

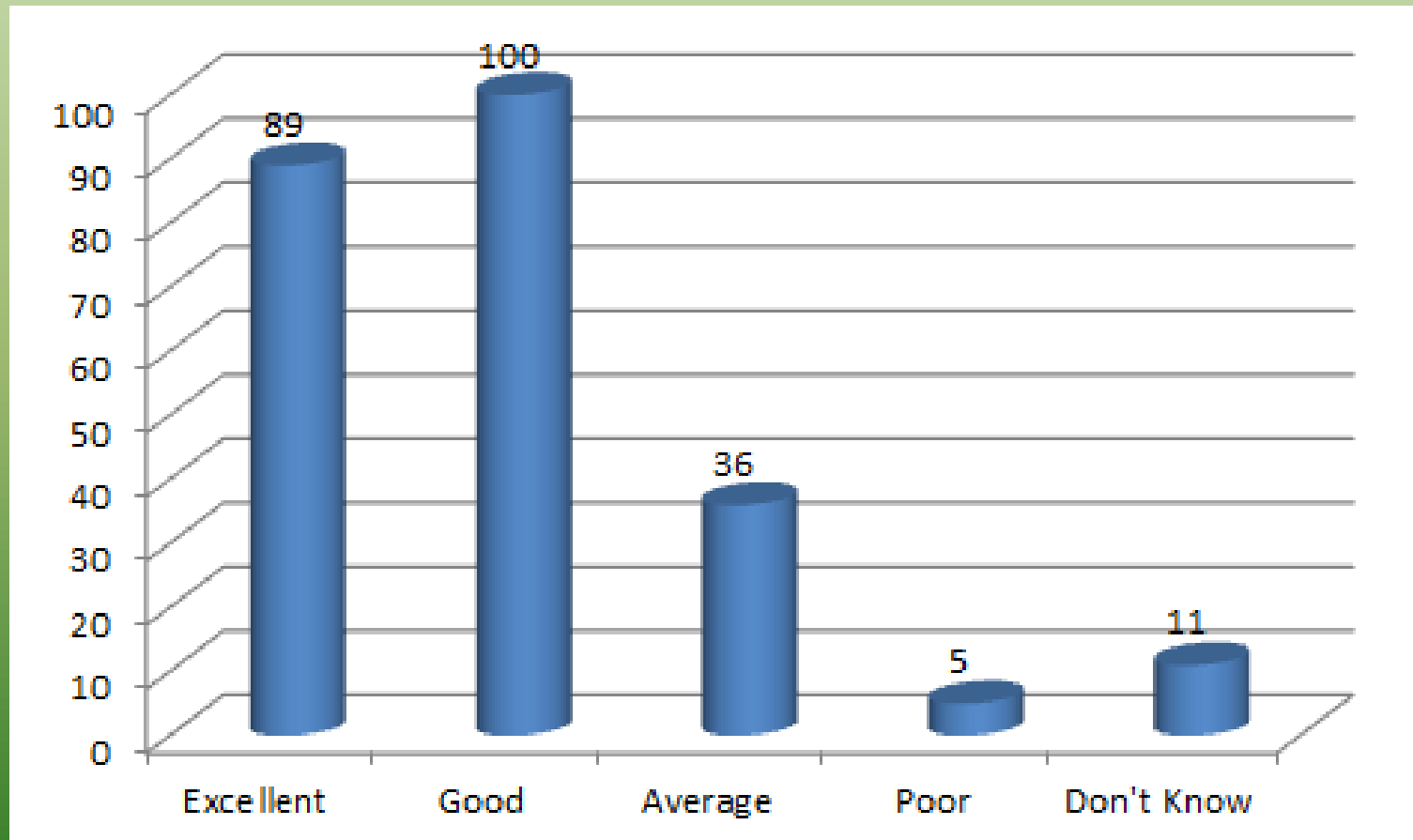

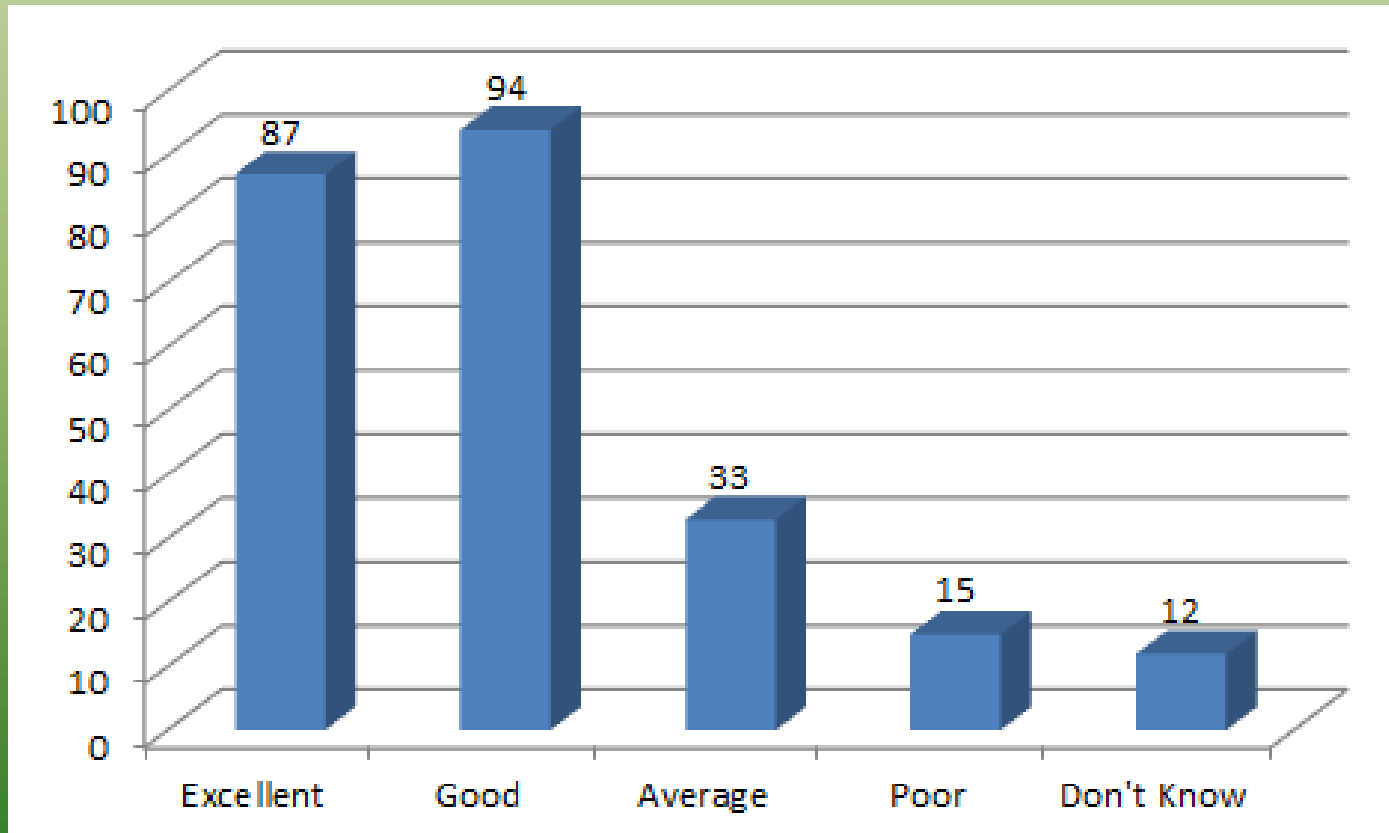
The curriculum includes content and learning experiences that provide students the knowledge and skills needed for future success.



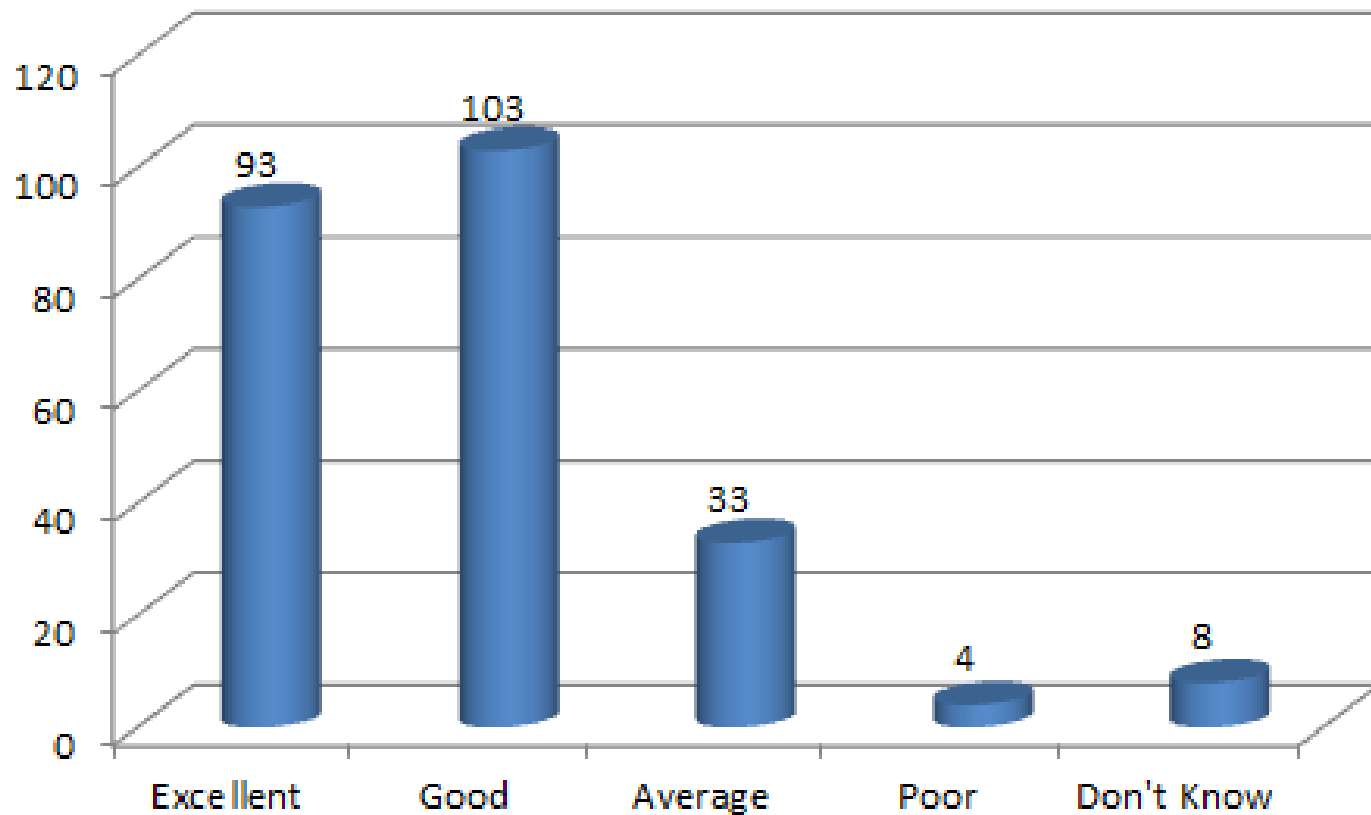
