As an Aunt and Uncle Family, you will be assigned to a TA for the entire school year. You will be 'extended family' and their additional support and resource for questions, transportation and friendship. Being an Aunt and Uncle family is a great way to learn about our important TA Program, and to build relationships with the young adults who enrich our students' educational experience!

Responsibilities:

- Work as a team with the host families to support the TA.
- Support your TA by providing rides each week during the school year (possibly 2-3 times a wk)
- Organize a social event with your TA at least once per month (such as: dinner at home, activity with kids or other family outing).
- Help to move your TA from first host family to second host family in January

Benefits:

- Great opportunity to connect with and learn about a young adult from foreign country
 - Car rides are a great time to converse and connect with TAs and for TAs to practice English
 - More exposure to the TA program and other RSI families
 - Children often feel special at school to know TAs
 - Expose your kids to the Spanish language in a setting outside of school
 - Attend three social events involving TAs and host and aunt and uncle families, usually a fall and winter outing and Holiday party
