- Update from the Principals (Ken Habel & Dr. Alejandra Estrada-Burt) 10 minutes
 - Rep. Ilhan Omar visited RSI on 10/24. Natasha Rice is an RSI alum and is working on Rep. Omar's team.
 Rep. Omar shared her personal story and her current job duties as a congressional representative visited 3 classrooms- including (2) 4th grade, and (1) 2nd grade classrooms
 - Continuing to work with the Center for Biliteracy on biliteracy curriculum and evidence-based strategies for multilingual learners
 - 5th graders went on their first field trip in 2 years to Baker Park for a fun outdoor-learning experience
 - o Great start to the first 7 weeks of school, including fall conferences and bookfair
 - Colin Ernste- RSI full time counselor- ran Unity Day Logros Assembly, first school-wide assembly.
 Discussed anti-bullying, reinforcing 2nd step curriculum in classrooms; important step in creating school community
 - staff able to reach more students due to increased support staff this year, including a full-time school counselor, full-time school social worker and psychologist, and a support student specialist
 - MTSS- multi-tiered system support framework to help ensure positive social, emotional, behavioral, developmental, and academic outcomes for every student.
- Treasurer's Report (Morgan Wallace- Johnson) 10 minutes

 - Sept and Oct expenditures reviewed as well as current balance status
 - October Dine to Donate: \$668.20 raised
 - Grant Applications & Vote
 - 2 grant periods, fall and spring each school year
 - Includes budgeted funds and can include excess funds as available
 - Grants brought to the General Assembly meetings to vote upon have been approved by the principals and the PTO board
 - Grant 1: from Marie Bridge (RSI Media teacher) for hosting author Anika Fajardo
 - \$878.75 (one-time fee)
 - \$750 presentation fee + \$128.75 for book purchases
 - Author who developed original story for the movie Encanto and authored 2 children's books; was born in Columbia and raised in Minnesota
 - Would benefit 200 students, grades 4 & 5, and a small group of 5th grade students identified with interest in writing for a small-group writing workshop
 - Motion made to approve this grant by Sarah Taylor. Steph Hanna seconded it. Passed.
 - Grant 2: from Marie Bridge (RSI Media teacher) for Media Center/Library enhancements including additional furniture
 - To provide more space for group work, meet sensory needs, and help update current media center environment
 - \$7546.77- current request, includes list of specific furniture items w/ shipping costs included

- Requires approval from General Assembly, but because of amount requested and financial laws within the school district, will need to have approval from the school district as well, if supported by the General Assembly
 - Principals think think timeline for district approval could be by year-end, and that completion of the project could be by end of the 22-23 school year
- High impact -- will benefit all students and includes longevity for additional years of benefits to future students
- Last Media Center upgrade was at least 8+ years ago, likely longer, per principals
- Additional questions:
 - Question asked about carpet and fabric material of proposed items. Reviewed that current proposed items are mostly from LakeShore Learning- and materials meet safety codes as well as are known for ease of cleaning and longevity as they are widely used within educational settings
 - Suggestion made to request approval for an amount slightly over the current requested amount to allow for potential variation w/ item pricing or shipping cost changes.
- Motion made to increase amount of grant to \$10,000-11,000 and approve the grant at this monetary level by Nicole Armstrong. Motion seconded by Kathryn Diaz. Passed.
- Grant 3: from Colin Ernste (RSI school counselor) for Youth Frontier Kindness Retreat in Spring 2023
 - \$2950
 - Includes all 4th and 5th grade students, 5-hour program, on-site at school, providing interactive programming geared towards leadership and empowerment
 - Both principals support- aligns with 2nd step curriculum already used within the school
 - Positive feedback shared from a member who teaches in another district that has used this program with their students.
 - Principals shared support for program and goal for creating a culture of upperclassmen leadership skills to carry with them into future school years, as well as for the 5th graders to have a culmination experience at end of elementary, and to build leadership of the 4th grade students
 - Motion made to approve this grant by Nicole Armstrong. Motion seconded by Sarah Taylor. Passed.

 - Typically raises over \$20,000 for the school
